



BasicMed Paperwork Reduction Act Notice

The information collection is conducted in accordance with the requirements of 44 USC § 3507, as amended by section 2 of the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995. The information collected on this form is necessary to determine eligibility to exercise pilot privileges under BasicMed and is consistent with the FAA's authority to regulate and promote safety in air commerce under 49 USC 44701; see also the Federal Aviation Administration Extension, Safety, and Security Act of 2016, Pub. L. 114-190 § 2307, Medical Certification of Certain Small Aircraft Pilots. When all requirements have been met, an entry will be made in the airman's record noting BasicMed course completion. The FAA estimated that it will take each user .5 hours per user to complete the BasicMed Comprehensive Medical Examination Checklist, and 0.75 hours per user to complete the online training, certification, and consent. The information is required to be eligible to exercise pilot privileges under BasicMed and will become part of the Privacy Act system of records DOT/FAA 847, General Air Transportation Records on Individuals. Note that an agency may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to a collection of information unless it displays a currently valid OMB control number.
